DIRECTIONS TO NEW VENUE!!

Sheraton Parsippany Hotel, 199 Smith Road, Parsippany, New Jersey 07054

FROM THE NORTH: Take Interstate 287 South to Exit 42. Proceed to the light and turn left onto Parsippany Road. Continue to the next traffic light and turn left to Route 46. Turn right onto Smith Road (after the Gas Station). The hotel is .25 miles on the left.

FROM THE SOUTH: Take Interstate 287 North to Exit 41A. Follow signs for Route 46 and Smith Road, and bear right onto the ramp and turn right at the end of the ramp onto Smith Road. The hotel is on the left.

FROM THE EAST: Take Interstate 80 West to Exit 34B. Follow the signs for Interstate 287 North. Take Route 46 and Smith Road exit. Turn right at the stop sign. Continue on to the light and turn right onto Smith Road. The hotel is .25 miles on the left.

FROM THE WEST: Take Interstate 80 East to Exit 42C. Follow US-202 North to the traffic light. Proceed on through the light to the end of the road. Turn right onto Smith Road. The hotel is .25 miles on the left.
